This Saare 41.2 is excellent and very well equipped for long journeys. It not only has a very large lithium battery bank with 3 batteries of 200 Ah at 24 V (~14.4 kWh capacity) which also power the electric oven and the induction cooker, but also a solar bracket with 4 solar modules of 125 Wp each, in which the Davids and an outboard lift are also integrated.

In addition, the mainsheet is conveniently moved on the Targa bracket which connects to the sprayhood. This leaves the cockpit free and the vertical cockpit closure can be easily connected to the Targa bracket.

Whether Baltic Sea, Mediterranean, Atlantic or more northern regions, this Saare is ready for it.
